The white color is procured by soaking, drying, and churning seashell, The red color is derived from a stone named Hingula, yellow is obtained from a stone Haritlal, Green is secured from leaves and green stones, and black is obtained from lampblack, or either from burning coconut shell.120 more colors are used by mixing of the Pancha Tatwa color. The hair of, mouse, buffalo, and Keya roots are used for brush for the painting. It is tied to a bamboo stick as a brush handle. The flower border on the painting makes it more impressive

Laxmi is the household goddess of most Hindu families. The word Laxmi is derived from the Sanskrit words Lakshya. She is the goddess of wealth and prosperity and fortune. Goddess Laxmi rises out of the churning of the milky ocean, known as "Khira Sagar" during the tug of war between the god and demons, seated on a full blossomed lotus. She herself choose Lord Vishnu as her husband.

Se has always been associated with Lord Vishnu. Whenever Lord Vishnu, took birth on earth in human form, goddess Laxmi also incarnated as human form along with him. When Lord Vishnu incarnated as Vamana, Goddess Laxmi incarnated as the Padma. When Lord Vishnu incarnated as Parasurama, Goddess Laxmi incarnated as Dharani. 

Pattachitra means cloth painting an aged and popular art of Odisha. Which displays pictorial stories and live events from Hindu mythology.

The colors used in the painting are purely made from natural ingredients. The white color extract from seashells was powdered soaked to make the white paste. The color green is made from the green leaf and green stones. Red is made from a local stone called Hingula. Another stone named Khandaneela was used to extract the color blue. The yellow is made from, stone named Hartal. Black is extracted by burnt coconut shell. These five colors are also called Pancha Tatwa. 120 other colors are made by using these five main colors. Every color has its own significance, as the white illustrates Laughter (Hasya), Red stands furious, astonishment in yellow, The hair of the mouse and Buffalo used to make brushes and tied to the end of a bamboo stick. The floral border makes the art astonishingly beautiful.

Krishna's favorite thing is playing his flute, and whenever he plays his flute the Gopikas of Vrindavan joins him enjoying, dancing, and his divine love Radha was lost in his eyes of beloved. It is said that in the summer season Lord Krishna with his Beloved love Radha and other Gopikas, sail through the Yamuna river in Nauka(boat) and enjoy the breeze.

Gopis are those saints and sages who penance for years to become devotees of Lord Krishna, in incarnation. Gopis are spellbound in joy whenever they see Lord Krishna playing the flute. Their expression of love towards him is like a devotee towards his God. Bhakti is more blissful than liberation.

The above picture depicts the wonderful portrayal of that majestic moment of Lord Krishna Nauka Vihar. Their names can not be taken without each other, perfect definition of love via soul is represented in the picture. The sourcing and application of colors and materials are purely natural. Five colors white, red, yellow, green, black, known as Pancha Tatwa been used to color the Picture. The white color gets by soaking, drying, and churning seashell, The red extract from a stone named Hingula, a local stone Haritlal used for yellow, Green used from leaves and green stones, and black is obtained from lamp soot, or either from burning coconut shell.120 more colors are used by mixing of the Pancha Tatwa color. The hair of, mouse, buffalo, and Keya roots are used to make the brush for the painting. And tied to a bamboo stick for the brush handle. The flower border on the painting makes it more notable.





- The wheel is a replica of the Konark wheel, with 8 spokes installed on a pedestal having similar decoration at the end.
- The wheel is removable from its pedestal.
- The architectural elegance is a masterpiece of the heritage, made by skilled artisans of Odisha.

The great wheel of Konark:

- The wheel is also known as the "wheel of life".
- The wheel is the base of the chariot, consisting of 8 wider spoke and 8 thinner spoke.
- The spokes signify the Prahars (three-hour periods) of a day.
- Distance between 2 wider spokes is 180 minutes and the thinner spoke between two wider spokes is 90 minutes. There are 30 beads between one wider spoke to the next thinner

spoke and each bead represents 3 minutes. The Sundial shows time anti-clockwise and the top center wider spoke represents midnight.

- You can also place it on your study, office, reception desk, coffee table, etc.
- It can place at any office and home decoration as it represents the image of the world heritage.
