An absolute piece of skillfully carved Ganesha statue is an ancient practice of sculpting stone into art and craft in the Indian state of Odisha. This Ganesha statue has seen dancing with six arms along with the gana's, attendant of Shiva. Lord Ganesha has been appointed as the leader of all gana's by his father Lord Shiva.

Lord Ganesha has 32 forms, each of which carries different items which have important spiritual significance. Here he is seen with a goad in the upper right-hand goad (known as ankusa) which is used on elephants to move faster, signifies Ganesha god direct us to move forward in the righteous path in our life. In left upper arm holding a noose or paasa which use to control an animal, signifies, Lord Ganesha captures all hardships from the path of his devotee, holding a broken tusk in his lower left hand, which he himself broke while writing Mahabharat Epic from sage Vyasa, symbolic of sacrifice for the right cause. In his lower right hand holding his favorite sweet, a reward of spiritual life or you can say this signifies "sat chit anand" means inner joy. Again the axe signifies cutting off all trobles from the path, and the prayer beads his devotion toward spiritual life and calm nature. The lord sculpture is incomplete without his mount, rat represents Ganesha's ability to control any troublesome situation or creature. One soul gets purified with the divine blessing of the god's statues. This Ganesha decor, not only

opens a way of positivity and spiritual vibe into life but also decorates your space in a sophisticated manner. Also a classy gift for your loved ones on various occasions. **Placing:** It will be more beneficial if you keep the idol in the east or to the east direction of your selected place. And one thing to be considered while placing him at the entrance of any building, home or office, place him in such a way that the back of the idol should always face the main entrance. Here as he is in sandy fawn color so consider the background should a light one. **Care:** Just dust it with a cloth (dry) or broom periodically.
